



NOTICE OF PRIVACY PRACTICES

It is the policy of Acadia Total Health, LLC (Clinic) to maintain patient privacy and comply with governmental regulations related to medical information. The United States government created specific rules for the use and protection of medical information by health care providers. The rules are a result of the 1966 Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act ("HIPAA") and are meant to provide patients with standard privacy protections.

One rule requires health care providers to provide its patients with a Notice of Privacy Practices to explain how medical information is used. Along those lines, the clinic Notice of Privacy Practices ("Notice") is available to you at any time, found at ATH receptionist desk or online to comply with the HIPAA rules and it intended to answer questions you may have about how medical information is used by the clinic/providers.
